ENERGY AWARDED RENFREWSHIRE COUNCIL FRAMEWORK

Emtec Energy has successfully been awarded the 2nd phase framework contract for Renfrewshire Schools Solar PV. The scheme involves 10 different schools across the council, under a tight programme prior to the potential FIT digression in January.
